Please remember to check your child's folder each day. We will check for notes from you each day, also.

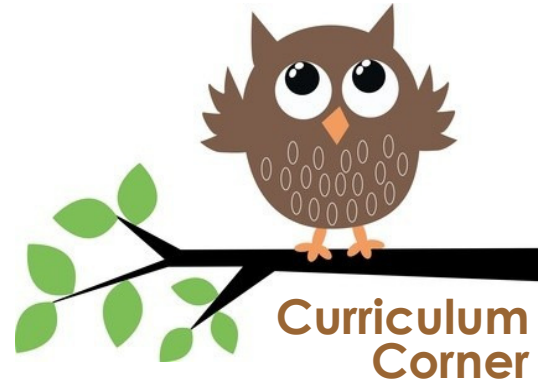
