Rental applications must be filled out in full with the waiver signed and dated in order to process your application. Proof of residency must be provided and security deposit paid. Reservations may be placed in person at either Community Center, via email or fax. No reservations will be taken via phone or on-line. Reservations are approved on a first-come, first-served basis, as measured by the receipt of a complete application and all related deposits and fees. Submitting an application is not a confirmation of the rental. The charge card on file will be charged the balance on the day of your outing before entering the facility. Full payment is due after the group has been counted and have met with the Aquatic Staff. The attendance form is due upon arrival to the Aquatic Center and will accompany the approved application to verify guests in the group. Gurnee Park District reserves the right to reassign space without notice. Park District programs have priority in scheduling. Fees are subject to change.

## General Information

**Behavior:** All activities must be conducted in an orderly manner. Foul or abusive language, attempted/physical confrontation is not permitted and will result in immediate expulsion from the facility.

**Cancellations:** Must be in writing from the renter listed on the application 2 weeks prior to the rental date in order to receive a refund of all rental fees less a \$15.00 service charge. After that time, no refunds are issued for cancellations including all rental fees paid.

**Closure:** The Aquatic Center may be closed if the temperature is below 70 degrees, moderate to heavy rainfall, visible thunder, lightning or ThorGuard system is in alarm. In case of inclement weather where cancellation is made by the Aquatic Center staff, the Pool Manager will make every effort to notify you. Decision to open the pool is made at 9:00a daily. If you are unsure on the opening status, please contact our rainout line at 847-268-2080. If we close due to weather within 30 minutes of your arrival, we will be happy to reschedule your trip. If your rental is underway and there is a pool closing, you will be refunded half the rate if it closes before half the rental time. If it closes after half the rental time, no money will be refunded.

**Guests:** All swimmers must shower before entering the pool. For children under 8 years old, there must be 1 adult in the water within arm's reach for every 8 children in the water. For children 9 years old and older, there must be 1 adult in the water within arm's reach for every 10 children in the water. **Group Leaders must be in the water with their group at all times.**

**Liability Insurance:** Your organization is required to provide a Certificate of Insurance with a one million dollar General Liability Coverage having the Gurnee Park District listed as additionally insured by the insurance company. A copy must be provided to the Park District prior to your event. Liability insurance is waived if your camp group is a member of PDRMA. (Park District Risk Management Agency)

**Payment:** MasterCard, VISA, Discover, cash and checks accepted. A \$25 service charge will be assessed on all NSF checks. Your deposit is applied to the rental. The charge card on file will be charged the balance due on the day of the outing before entering the facility. Full payment is due after the group has been counted and have met with the Aquatic Staff. Fee is per Camper; Group Leaders are free! Children under 3 are free; Aquatic Center season passes do not apply.

**Renter:** Renter must be 21 years of age or older and in attendance during the entire event. The renter will assume full responsibility for the rental and liability and is solely responsible for the actions of any member of the group both in and out of the water.

**Special Needs:** If someone in your group has a special need, please let us know in advance and we will be happy to arrange any necessary reasonable accommodations.

**Swim Testing:** Swim testing will be conducted before use of the pool. Non-Swimmers will be restricted to shallow water only. To use the deep end, swimmers must be able to swim front crawl without stopping, for one length of the pool. The Pool Manager will test swimmers if they appear weak or fatigued.

## Arrival Instructions

**Busses:** For everyone's safety, busses may unload and load at the front entrance. Designated bus parking is available in the Southeast back lot.

**Camp Staff:** Leaders should check in at the Aquatic entrance then bring their group to the side gate where they will be met by Aquatic Staff to go over rules / procedures prior to entry. To ensure your guests safety, attendance sheets verifying Camper to Leader ratio is due upon arrival.

Camp Site Directors should not be included in the Camper-to-Leader ratios.

Everyone will be given a wristband to identify their camp which needs to be worn at all times. All groups are assigned areas on the grass where they may keep their belongings. Please do not utilize the deck chairs.

## Aquatic Center General Rules & Guidelines

**Attire:** Health Department regulations stipulate proper bathing suit attire is required and must be worn at all times. No underwear, street clothes, cutoffs, basketball shorts, shoes or diapers are allowed. Children who are not toilet trained **must** wear swim diapers and a tight fitting rubber or plastic swim pant over the diaper. *Both Swim Diapers) and Swim Pants are available for purchase at the Ticket Office for your convenience.* T-shirts may not be worn while swimming except for medical reasons. Aqua-Shirts are allowed.

**Lifeguards:** Our Ellis & Associates trained Lifeguards are there for your safety, to enforce rules and respond to emergencies. Please follow their instructions along with the pool rules posted throughout the facility at all times.

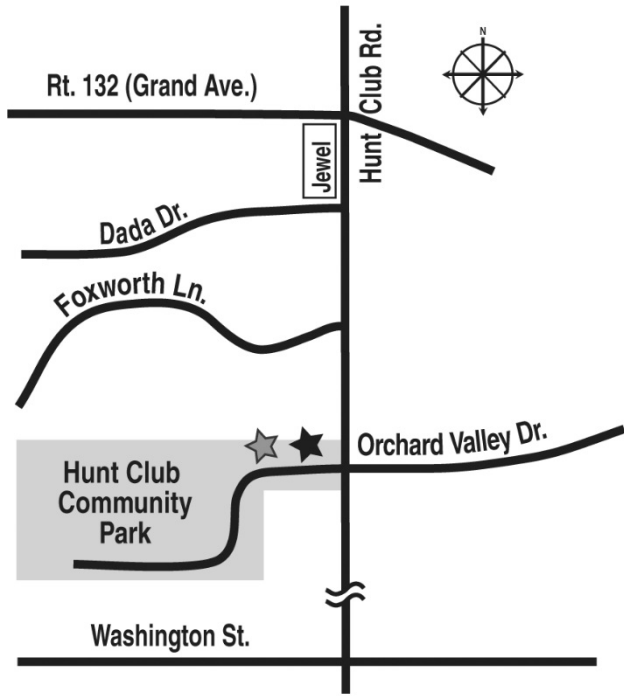
**Lifejackets:** U.S. Coast Guard approved lifejackets are available for use, free of charge. For children using lifejackets, 1 adult to 1 child ratio must be met.

**Personal Flotation Devices / Water Toys:** Inflatable personal flotation devices, masks, fins, snorkels, squirt guns, sharp plastic toys, diving sticks, pool noodles, water wings, and specialty equipment are prohibited.

**Refreshments:** We offer a concession stand with numerous amenities. Carry in food is allowed and must be kept in the grassy picnic area or on the concession deck only. No glass is allowed in the facility and all garbage must be placed in the trash receptacles. **The concession stand opens at 11:00am.**

Additionally, Renter understands and agrees that children 12 years of age and younger must be supervised at all times by a responsible person, 16 years of age or older and it is renter's responsibility to enforce this requirement. Accordingly, renter agrees that he/she shall communicate this requirement to all guests/patrons associated with and attending this event. Renter agrees to protect, indemnify, save and hold harmless Gurnee Park District including its officers, officials, employees, agents and volunteers (collectively "District") from and against any and all liabilities, obligations, claims, damages, causes of action, costs and expenses, (including reasonable attorney fees) which Gurnee Park District may become obligated by reason of any accident, injury, or drowning of any member of Renter's group (or caused by a member of Renter's group) arising indirectly or directly in connection with or under this agreement.

Gurnee Park District is not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged personal items or personally rented equipment.
